




## Corps Navigation Mission

**Provide safe, reliable, efficient, effective and environmentally sustainable waterborne transportation systems for movement of commerce, national security needs, and recreation.**




# Civil Works Appropriations FY 2005 Funding

## **National Dredging Program**

### **DREDGING FY 04**

- **Total dredging - \$903.1 million,  
274.2 million cubic yards**
- **Corps - \$95.9 million (10.6%),  
35.2 million cubic yards (12.8%)**
- **Industry - \$807.3 million (89.4%),  
239.1 million cubic yards (87.2%)**
