- 61 Breakwaters/jetties





HISTORY

- 1910 - First settlers arrive
- 1918 - Initial Dock constructed
- 1920 - Anchorage becomes Incorporated
- 1940 - Military Dock constructed
- 1958 - Terminal 1 constructed.
- 1958 - R&H Act authorizes Federal dredging to -35' MLLW.
- 1959 - Alaska becomes 49th State.
- 1961 - Port of Anchorage established.

HISTORY (Cont.)

1964 - Earthquake puts Port out of service for 3 weeks.

1970 - Terminal 2 Constructed. Container cranes installed.

1975 - Terminal 3 Constructed.

1976 - Section 199 of WRDA authorizes O&M of expanded port.

1992 - POL 2 Constructed. MOA w/ Port for initial dredging.

1996 - Section 101 of WRDA authorizes construction of Cook Inlet Navigation Channel.



RECENT LEGISLATION

AK Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities

Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2005, PL 108-447, Section 118 authorizes the Secretary of the Army to construct and maintain a harbor to -45 ft MLLW for a length of 10,860 feet.
