POSITION: This is a Non-Competitive Supervisory opportunity for a GS-15 employee that has held a GS-15 position on a permanent basis. Candidate should have evidence of progressively responsible leadership experience with managerial capability that directly relates to this position.

Position will be filled as a: GS 15-CIVIL ENGINEERING/CHEMIST/ARCHITECT, GENERAL ENGINEER/MECHANICAL ENGINEER/ELECTRICAL ENGINEER, PROGRAM MANAGER, BIOLOGIST, PARK RANGER, OUTDOOR RECREATION PLANNER, ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION SPECIALIST, PHYSICAL SCIENTIST, SOCIAL SCIENTIST, OR FACILITY MANAGER.

DESCRIPTION MAJOR/DUTIES: Chief, Operations and Regulatory Division
Summary: Serves as line supervisor and technical expert for staff whose principal responsibility is providing direction, guidance, and assistance to USACE divisions and districts on matters in the operations and regulatory functional areas. Ensures timely execution of Civil Works Operations, Maintenance and Regulatory program policies established by the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Civil Works (ASA(CW)). Oversees the development and review of budgets for Operations and Maintenance (O&M), aquatic plant control, recreation research, regulatory/Clean Water Act activities, and other functions such as hydroelectric power, environmental restoration, wildlife management, and protection of waterways and wetlands. Manages Civil Works water resources project master plan development, O&M of public use facilities, and user fee collection. Assures program guidance is provided to divisions and districts for all work affecting waters of the United States. Monitors Operations and Regulatory Division activities within Headquarters (HQUSACE), divisions, and districts, assuring that implementation of programs and policies is consistent with those established by the ASA(CW) and HQUSACE. Provides staff supervision of Marine Design Center for Director of Civil

Works. Chairs USACE Marine Engineering Board. Serves as Chief of a Regional Integration Team (RIT), providing primary point of contact for a Regional Business Center (RBC) in Washington. Is RBC's executive representative for all mission and support areas, resolving issues within assigned area of expertise. Works closely with other RITs and Programs Integration Division in executing mission areas, including resource and program requirements. Maintains an in-depth understanding of all programs and projects within the region.

About the Position: The incumbent will serve as the Acting Chief of the Operations and Regulatory Division (CECW-CO) and Chief of the Great Lakes and Ohio River Division Regional Integration Team (LRD-RIT), Directorate of Civil Works.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: Applicants must currently possess a SECRET security clearance. Term of the appointment no less than six months and not to exceed one year. Permanent Change of Station (PCS) expenses WILL NOT be authorized. Salary, travel and per diem will be funded by HQUSACE.

EVALUATION CRITERIA: Applicants will be evaluated based on the information provided.
